

Cemetery Policy

The purpose of CBHT owning and maintaining a cemetery is to provide a benefit for its members and their immediate families. It is with that intention that this policy seeks to clarify the eligibility of individuals to purchase and utilize space at its current facility at Riverside Cemetery in Asheville.

Space remaining in the parcel known as Section 3 is the only area that can support a full, in-ground burial. This area shall furthermore be restricted for sale to members in good standing (as defined by the then current bylaws). The determination as to purchase eligibility for burial in this section shall be as follows:

Member rates (based on the current rate as determined by the Board) shall apply to the members, their immediate families (defined as parents and children under the age of 25 years).

Plots may be purchased for children who are older than 25 years, grandchildren and member siblings at the prevailing non-member rates.

Cremation of members, and immediate family members defined above may be interred on the same plot as is already in service, however an additional fee will be required at the full member rate. A single plot will be restricted to a maximum of three internments (combining a single traditional burial with up to two cremations).

The only plots that are eligible for purchase by non-members not expressly covered in the sections above will be in the designated area in Section 2 which is restricted to cremations. The cost for these plots will be at the non-member rates, regardless of the number of individuals interred in a plot (limited to a maximum of three).

This policy was ratified by the Board of Congregation Beth HaTephila on August 26, 2014.
